PURA's mandate in the Electricity sector is derived from the Electricity Act of 2005.

Public Utilities Regulatory Authority is set to introduce the first-ever electricity code for the effective management, governance and regulation of The Gambia's power and energy sector.

The Government of The Gambia commits to supporting the ERERA tariff working group on the harmonization of transmission pricing within the WAPP zone to facilitate cross-border electricity trade.

This Act provides rules for the generation, storage and distribution of electricity in The Gambia.
