China installed a record 60 gigawatts (GW) of new solar photovoltaic (PV) capacity in the first quarter of 2025 - the highest ever recorded in a first quarter in the country's history, according to ...

Wind and solar now account for 37% of the total power capacity in the country, an 8% increase from 2022, and widely expected to surpass coal capacity, which is 39% of the total right ...

China's solar power capacity has surpassed 1 TW, marking a historic milestone as the country accelerates its energy transition. Around 92 GW of new PV systems were installed in China ...

Given that China is by far both the world's largest greenhouse gas emitter and coal consumer, its domestic solar deployments will have global consequences. However, several hurdles ...

China is leading the world in new solar and wind installations and doing so at a record-shattering pace. In May 2025 alone, the country added 93 gigawatts of solar capacity, or nearly 100 ...

So there is a lot of uncertainty in the Chinese solar industry, but there are also irrefutable facts: China needs to continue to expand domestic solar capacity to reach its climate target....

China's cumulative installed solar power capacity surpassed 1 TW in May after nearly 200 GW of new solar plants came online in the first five months of the year, according to official data ...

China has more utility-scale solar than any other country. The 277 GW of utility-scale solar capacity installed in China in 2024 alone is more than twice as much as the 121 GW of utility ...

In the first half of 2025, the country installed more than twice as much solar capacity as the rest of the world combined, accounting for 67% of global additions.

China's installations of wind and solar in May are enough to generate as much electricity as Poland, as the
