In CY2024, China hit a new record of annual net new capacity added to the grid at 429GW, a 21% y-o-y increase. Of this, wind and solar power combined capacity accounted for 83% at 356.5GW, dwarfing ...

According to the NEA posted on its website on Thursday, as of the end of 2025, China's total installed power generation capacity reached 3.89 billion kilowatts, up 16.1 percent year-on-year.

Wind and solar power surpassed thermal power in terms of installed capacity for the first time ever in the first quarter of last year. As of March. 31, 2025, China's installed capacity of wind and ...

By the end of 2024, China had exported a total of 5,799 wind turbines with a cumulative capacity of 20.788 million kW to 57 countries across six continents. Official data showed that during ...

By the end of 2023, China's cumulative installed capacity of wind power was 441 GW, an increase of 20.7% y-o-y. Wind power thus accounted for 15% of the total installed power, of which 404 GW was ...

Hydropower accounted for 436 million kilowatts, wind power for 521 million kilowatts, solar power for 887 million kilowatts, and biomass power for 46 million kilowatts.

By the end of 2023, China's cumulative installed capacity of wind power is 441 million kW, ranking first in the world for 14 consecutive years.

According to the National Energy Administration, China's total installed power generation capacity reached around 3.9 billion kilowatts by the end of 2025, up 16.1% year on year.
