Access to electricity in Zambia has risen from 30% in 2017 to currently nearly 50%. Whilst half of the population is connected, the remaining half will require new energy solutions.

Zambia's solar market is poised for significant growth in the next 3-5 years, driven by increasing electricity demand, falling technology costs, and government support for renewable energy.

The combination of rising tariffs and power shortages is likely to accelerate the adoption of residential solar projects, such as solar inverters, solar power systems, and solar panels, in Zambia.
